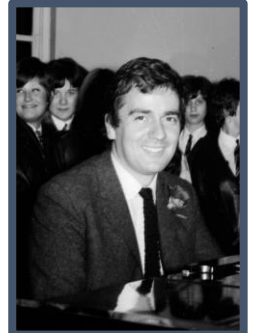


Famous Faces Crossword

- 19. Former Albert Square tough guy and journalist (4,4)
- 20. Football team Bobby Moore joined in 1958 (4,3)
