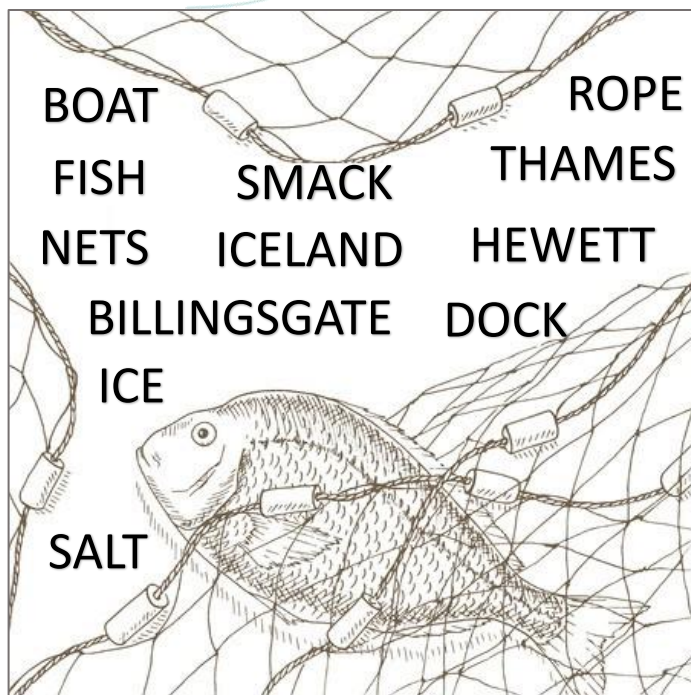




Wade the Whale's Fishy Wordsearch **ANSWERS**
